

ORDINANCE 2015 - 01

**CITY OF DUNDAS
RICE COUNTY
STATE OF MINNESOTA**

*An Ordinance Amending Section 1102
of the Dundas City Code Regarding
Alcoholic Beverages*

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DUNDAS DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 1102.03 DEFINITIONS is hereby amended as follows:

“Brew Pub” is a brewer who also holds one or more retail on-sale licenses and who manufactures fewer than 3,500 barrels of malt liquor in a year, at any one licensed premises, the entire production of which is solely for consumption on tap on any licensed premises owned by the brewer, or for off-sale from those licensed premises as permitted in Minn. Stat. section 340A.24, subdivision 2.

SECTION 2. Section 1102.07(A) of the Dundas City Code is hereby amended as follows:

§1102.07 TYPES OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSES

(A) License Categories. Licenses for intoxicating liquor shall be of the following categories, which license shall be granted only for the purposes permitted by state statutes and limited by this chapter:

(3) Sunday on-sale intoxicating liquor licenses, which may be issued only to a restaurant, bowling center, club, or hotel which has a seating capacity of at least 30 persons, which holds an on-sale intoxicating liquor license and which serves liquor in conjunction with the service of food. The hours for Sunday sales shall be as allowed under Minn. Stat. 340A.504, as amended.

(5) Brew pub on-sale intoxicating liquor or on sale 3.2 percent malt liquor licenses, which may be issued to a brew pub for a restaurant operated in the place of manufacture.

(6) Brew Pub Off-Sale Licenses, which may be issued to a brew pub that holds an on-sale license, with the approval of the Commissioner of Public Safety, for off-sale of malt liquor produced and packaged on the licensed premises. Off-sale of malt liquor shall be limited to the legal hours for off-sale at exclusive liquor stores and the malt liquor sold must be removed from the premises before the applicable off-sale closing time at exclusive liquor stores. Packaging of malt liquor for off-sale must comply with Minn. Stat. 340A.285.

(7) Small-Brewer off-sale intoxicating liquor licenses, which may be issued to a brewer licensed under Minn. Stat. section 340A, subd.6, clause (c), (i) or (j), for off-sale of malt liquor at its licensed premises that has been produced and packaged by the brewer. The license must be approved by the Commissioner of Public Safety. Off-sale of malt liquor is limited to the legal hours for off-sale at exclusive liquor stores in the city. Malt liquor sold off-sale must be removed from the premises before the applicable off-sale closing time at exclusive liquor stores, except that malt liquor in growlers only may be sold at off-sale on Sundays. Packaging of malt liquor for off-sale must comply with section 340A.285. The amount of malt liquor sold at off-sale may not exceed 500 barrels annually. No license may be used under this section to a brewer if the brewer seeking the license, or any person having an economic interest in the brewer seeking the license or exercising control over the brewer seeking the license, is a brewer that brews more than 20,000 barrels of its own brands of malt liquor annually or a winery that produces more than 250,000 gallons of wine annually.

(12) Brewer Taproom License, may be issued to the holder of a brewer's license under §340A.301, subd.6, clause (c), (i), or (j) for the on-sale of malt liquor produced by the brewer for consumption on the premises of or adjacent to one brewery location owned by the brewer. A brewer taproom license may not issue to a brewer if the brewer seeking the license, or any person having an economic interest in the brewer seeking the license or exercising control over the brewer seeking the license, is a brewer that brews more than 250,000 barrels of malt liquor annually or a winery that produces more than 250,000 gallons of wine annually. A brewer taproom may be open and may conduct on-sale business on Sundays.

(13) Small Brewer or microdistillery temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license, with the approval of the Commissioner of Public Safety, to brewers who manufacture fewer than 3,500 barrels of malt liquor in a year or a microdistillery, for the on-sale of intoxicating liquor in connection with a social event with the city sponsored by the brewer or microdistillery.

(14) Microdistillery Cocktail Room License, which may be issued to the holder of a microdistillery license under Minn. Stat. 340A.22 for the on-sale of distilled liquor produced by the distiller for consumption on the premises of or adjacent to one distillery location owned by the distiller.

SECTION 3. Section 1102.16 HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE is hereby amended as follows:

(1) The hours and days of sale shall be those established by Minn. Stat. §340A.504, as amended.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication in accordance with law.

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of the Dundas City Code Regarding
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Chapter 1102 “Alcoholic Beverages” was amended by adding a definition of “brew pub”; allowing additional types of licenses for “brew pub off-sale”, “brewer taproom”, “microdistillery cocktail room” and “microdistillery temporary license”; allowing off-sale growlers on Sundays and allowing Sunday on-sales as established under state law; and making other minor language changes consistent with Minn. Stat. 340A.
