

ORDINANCE 2010-04

**CITY OF DUNDAS
STATE OF MINNESOTA**

*An Ordinance Establishing a Four-Year Term
for the Office of Mayor*

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute §412.022 provides that the council may, by ordinance, establish a four-year term for the office of mayor commencing with the ensuing term; and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best interests of the general public welfare of the City of Dundas to increase the term of Office of the Mayor from a two-year to a four-year term;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Dundas, Minnesota, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 300 of the Dundas City Code, is hereby amended by adding a new Section § 300.00 as shown by the language as follows:

§ 300.00 MAYOR – TERM OF OFFICE.

The Mayor for the City of Dundas shall serve a four-year term.

Section 2. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
