39 surveys were completed

Great feedback was provided

Virginia Kaczmarek will plan to join the April 10th Park Board meeting to share programming plans for the upcoming summer.

Preliminary findings from the survey – 2018 summer program questionnaire:

- 60% stated they would be interested in preschool programming near their home
- 68% said they would be interested in school age programming near their home
- 80% were interested in drop-in type programming
- 64% were interested in progressive programming (such as a 4 week program)
- 60% were interested in a one-time event program
- 90% were interested in sports, recreation or group game programs
- 67% were interested in arts & craft type programs
- 66% said they would participate in programming at Memorial Park
- 45% said they would participate in programming at Mill Park
- 35% said they would participate in programming at Pinnacle Park
- 35% would participate in programming at Millstone Park

Other information:

- Transportation did not seem to be a problem for most Dundas residents
- Swimming lessons with transportation to the Y - interest was about 35%

We are very excited with the survey results. The Y staff team will work on 2018 programming offerings and present that information to the Park Board in April. There appears to be a lot of potential for providing quality services for the youth in Dundas.

We wish to give Linda Ripka an EXTRA big thank you for helping us to get the word out and encouraging community members to share their feedback. She was wonderful to work with.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2018 - 13

*A Resolution Supporting SUPER Kids and Authorizing
Use of the Pavilion at Memorial Park*

WHEREAS, Northfield Public Schools has a summer program for children ages four to nine (4 to 9); and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Program Coordinator, Melissa Bernhard, has requested the City of Dundas allow a SUPER Kids Program to be conducted in Dundas and allow use and the Memorial Park along with the Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, SUPER Kids has provided a summer program for children at Memorial Park since 2010, and:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Dundas believes it is a valuable program to serve the community of Dundas;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Dundas, Minnesota, permit the Northfield Public Schools Community Service Division to use Memorial Park and the Pavilion from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on all Fridays mornings except July 6 during the period from June 15 to July 27, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does hereby waives any and all rental and deposit fees for the use of the Pavilion at Memorial Park and instruct City staff to make the Pavilion available to the Northfield Public Schools SUPER Kids program during the requested time period.
